About Burrell House - the home of Winchester Hospice

Burrell House, will be refurbished to house the Winchester Hospice - a 10-bedded hospice providing compassionate and specialist care.

Burrell House is located on the grounds of Royal Hampshire County Hospital, Winchester. Augusta Burrell was a generous benefactor, whose donations in the early 1900s meant a great deal of work could be done.

Now, the legacy of Augusta Burrell and Burrell House will continue as the central location for specialist end of life care for residents in and around Winchester.



We need over £2.5 million to refurbish Burrell House and turn it into Winchester Hospice. Thanks to a generous legacy, part of the money is already in place but we need your help to convert this building into a place where patients can live as well as possible.

Specialist care, from people who care

Winchester Hospice will support and empower patients with life limiting illnesses, and their families, through a number of end of life care services run by Hampshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. The Trust was rated 'Outstanding' for end of life care at the latest review by the Care Quality Commission.

"Based on the very successful hospice model in Andover, The Countess of Brecknock, our plan is for a 10 bed inpatient unit with ensuite facilities, which will feel more like a home than a hospital. Here, our patients and their families can continue to enjoy special moments together whilst being looked after by our specialist team." Dr Stephanie Killick, clinical lead for end of life care at Hampshire Hospitals, who will be lead consultant at the new hospice.

With your help, Winchester Hospice will also be able to provide a number of end of life care services at the hospice and in the community:

- Our 'Hospice at Home' service will expand to run overnight in the community to support patients in their own home when they are in their last few weeks of life.
- Hospice day services will be available for outpatients, who will be supported by specialist doctors, nurses and therapists without the need to be admitted.
- The Winchester Hospice will also have access to Hampshire Hospitals' Home Care Support Team, who provide care at home for patients at the end of their life.
